Bible story: Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.

Why is this important?

Stability is so important for children to learn. So many things in their lives may change. People grow older, friends come and go, and schedules change. But no matter what else may change, God is good and He never changes. This is a very reassuring concept for young children to grasp.

Object Lesson:

"Fall" in love with God:

People and things change around us. Today we're going to be talking about things that change. Do you know what season we are in? It's Fall! Can you tell me what things change in the fall time? (allow kids to answer discuss The weather, the colors of the leaves, less sunlight, and the time change. Ask them how they feel about all of these things changing)

Things change all around us all the time. But there is one thing we can always count on: God does NOT change! Isn't that wonderful? God does not change... ever. The Bible teaches us that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday. God loves us and nothing will ever separate us from that love in Jesus.

Can you make a happy face? Can you make a sad face or a frowny face? Can you make a scared face? An angry face? God loves us when we are happy and sad. He loves us whether we are scared or mad. God loves us all the time. And God never changes, so that means that God loves us forever and ever. Isn't that a good thing to know? Even if lots of things change around us, even if we change, God always loves us and God does NOT change.

Art Ideas:

"Fall" in love with Jesus

This example has pre cut leaves and has the child's hand traced and cut out, but for an easier option you can trace the child's hand on a piece of paper and have the child draw the leaves on a piece of paper.

Brainstorm with you child(ren) ways we know Jesus loves us. Wrote these reasons on the leaves.
